Student Voice

Criteria required

Reliable: Will you do everything you have promised to do and report back to the form class.

Fair: Will you represent the views of your class, even if you don't agree with them and give each pupil the same opportunity to give their opinions and value all views equally.

A good leader and listener: Will you lead a group discussion, listen to everyone's point of view and give advice. Agree to differ on opinions??

A good speaker: Will you speak clearly and concisely to get your point across and take part in discussions?
